- 1. In view of the strong concerns raised by some members of the University, the media and the public over the release of the results of the January 2012 Poll Survey on the Popularity of the 2012 Chief Executive Potential Candidates conducted by the HongCOMM Survey Lab of the School of Communication, the President and Vice-Chancellor set up an Investigation Panel convened by Prof. Rick W.K. Wong, Vice-President (Research and Development), to gain an in-depth understanding of the issue. The Investigation Panel conducted a thorough investigation and submitted the Report on the Poll Survey Issue to the Council.
- 2. After very careful deliberations, the Council unanimously endorsed the Report on the Poll Survey Issue submitted by the Investigation Panel.
